



## Bursary Application Process

- 1) Please complete the online application to the Queen's-Blyth Worldwide session(s), indicating in the notes that you are applying for a bursary.
- 2) Include the \$195 application fee. Note: If you cannot attend because your bursary application is declined, or if the bursary amount is insufficient to allow you to travel with Queen's-Blyth Worldwide, you may request a return of your \$500 deposit together with any purchased insurance. Application fees are non-refundable.
- 3) Please complete the bursary application form below, and return it to [info@queensblythworldwide.ca](mailto:info@queensblythworldwide.ca)
- 4) Please provide a 500-word essay explaining why you would like to study abroad, why you chose the particular program and course for which you are applying, and how you see yourself contributing to the Session.
- 5) If you are currently in receipt of a student loan, please submit a copy of your student loan notice of assessment. If you are not, or if you feel there are additional points of which the assessors should be aware, please provide a declaration of financial need in the form of a personal letter from a parent, guardian or yourself.
- 6) Submit one letter of reference from a professor, teacher or a leader in your community. This letter will help us determine past academic and community involvement, work ethic and desire to learn.

PLEASE SUBMIT ALL PORTIONS OF THE APPLICATION TO BE CONSIDERED (Letter of recommendation, application form, essay and student loan notice of assessment or declaration of financial need. Your application will not be accepted without all of these items).

The final deadline for application is Feb 15<sup>th</sup> 2012. Applications will be processed in the order which they are received, so earlier applicants have more chance of success, as funding is finite. Please note that most bursaries are for partial funding. Students will be expected to contribute to a portion of the Session costs.
